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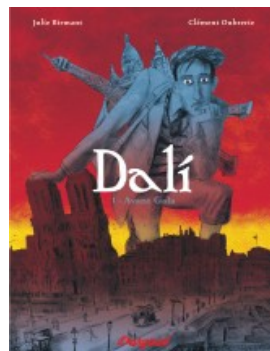
"I love Gala more than my mother, more than my father, more than Picasso, and even more than money."

The plot centers around Dali's relationship with Gala, a Russian girl and a former wife of Paul Eluard—a story about an intense passion that sometimes erupted into a cruel self-destruction.

Parallel to the Dali's story, the graphic novel follows the rise and fall of surrealist art and literature, centered on Paris and Barcelona, whose leading stars included Picasso, Breton, Ernst, Miro, Magritte, Lorca, Buñuel, and Eluard.

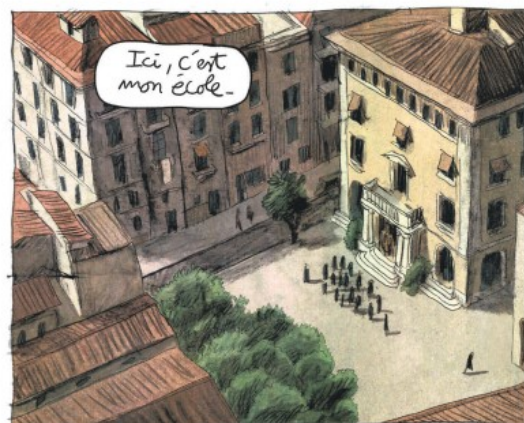
